


**DRM Workflow** 

#### Create

Enter or bulk upload profiles for any data provider, either those you've purchased from or those you simply want to track.

If the provider exists in Nomad's database of nearly 2,000 companies, all relevant details will be pulled in automatically. You can edit or enhance the profile with your own internal context.


Any provider you interact with via Connect will automatically populate into the list.



#### **Details**

For each provider you can view a general description of the company, all internal & external contacts, and all activity associated with that entity.


You can also add custom tabs and fields for internal-only details you want to track.



### Log an activity

Easily create a record of every relevant interaction with a provider.


You can also associate an activity to a specific data product, contact, and/or request.



### **Data products**

For each provider you can enter or bulk upload their data products and associated details such as pricing, purchase history, access instructions, and usage restrictions.


Just like on the provider view you can browse all activity associated with that particular data product.



### Requests

For each provider you can view every request associated with that company, including full details on the request, provider response, and all related conversations.

Any requests routed through Connect will automatically populate, or you can manually associate a request to a provider if the connection occurred outside of the platform.




### **Datasets & Contacts**

#### **Create, Details, and Requests**

Just like you can for data providers, you can create and view associated details for individual datasets and contacts.

In addition to external datasets you can create as many internal ones as you need. These datasets can be tagged in Reviewers' responses to requests in Enterprise Data Discovery.



### **Deal board**

#### **Details**

Catch up on the status of all data evaluations in a single view.

Every interaction with a provider is organized by status so you can stay on top of discussions firmwide, helping to spot potential double purchasing and move things along when they stall.
